Compressed air storage: Breathing new life into abandoned mines (remember the 2020 A-CAES pilot?)

Flow batteries: Liquid energy that works like a never-ending Tim Tam slam

Virtual power plants: Connecting 150,000 home batteries into a distributed energy orchestra
