2. Energy Cells (Extra Utilities 2)

3. The "MacGyver Special" - Flux-Infused Tools

Wait, tools as storage? Hear me out. Early game, your flux capacitor (no, not that kind) can store 400,000 RF



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while recharging your tools. It's like having a power bank in your pocket while mining. Multitasking level: SkyFactory god mode.

Pro Tips They Don't Tell You

Voltage control: Mix storage types to prevent "Christmas light syndrome" (one dead unit kills the chain)
Use Energy Laser Relays from Actually Additions for wireless charging stations
Pair storage with Surge Protectors - because lightning strikes suck more than accidental void drops
