Current promotions on Tmall include free Pinlock inserts worth \$45, making these arguably the smartest investment since helmet laws were invented.

Matching your helmet's LED pattern to your bike's underglow lights.

### Maintenance Myths Debunked

Contrary to forum folklore, these helmets don't require special care. The anti-fog coating survived my "breath test" (three minutes of Darth Vader impressions), and the removable pads machine-wash as well as my favorite hoodie. Just avoid using hair gel that could rival concrete in strength - nobody wants a crunchy helmet liner.

As the sun dips below the horizon, casting long shadows across the garage, one truth remains clear: In the helmet arms race, SOL continues to out-innovate competitors while keeping prices rider-friendly. Whether you're a daily commuter or weekend canyon carver, the H700/800 Solenso deserves a spot atop your gear wishlist. Now if they'd just add that birthday alarm feature...
