Camera Wars: From Megapixels to AI

The Nova13's 6000 (60MP ultra-wide front camera) isn't just hardware flex. Its AI skin-tone algorithm adapts to 27 different ethnic facial characteristics - a first in mass-market smartphones.

5G Detour and Satellite Comeback

The 2021-2023 Snapdragon era forced Huawei to innovate elsewhere. Nova12's (BeiDou satellite messaging) turned heads, with field tests showing 38% faster message transmission than competing solutions.

Average user retention: 2.7 years (vs industry 1.9)
