Interior Layout - The Good, The Tight, and The Clever

Rear seat magic: Flat-folding seats create 52.6 cubic feet of cargo space - enough for three checked suitcases or a medium-sized kayak

Front seat surprises: The secret compartment under the passenger seat could hide a laptop or emergency snacks

Door panel pockets: Angled bottle holders that actually fit 32oz Nalgene bottles without tipping

Unlike the Prius Prime's awkwardly shaped trunk, the C-MAX Energi uses vertical space like a Tetris champion. I once witnessed a owner transport a fully assembled IKEA Billy bookcase - though we don't recommend making that a habit.

The Battery Conundrum

Here's where things get spicy. The 7.6kWh lithium-ion battery (about the energy of 76 smartphone charges) claims 8.2 cubic feet of trunk space. But wait - that's before applying the "real-world shrinkage factor" familiar to EV owners. Practical measurements show:
