Mike from Arizona shares: "I used generic brackets on my Class C and lost a panel near Flagstaff. Upgraded to Z brackets - survived three hailstorms and a bear encounter!" Pro tip: Always use butyl tape and dicor sealant for waterproofing - your roof's integrity depends on it.
